The City of Ansonia's Cultural Commission would like to invite you to participate in their 11th Annual Harvest Festival to be held on Saturday, October 4, 2014, with a rain date of October 11th. The event will take place all along Main Street from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Once again, there will be a contest for "Scarecrows on Main Street", which merchants and organizations are being encouraged to participate in. We are also planning a pumpkin carving contest involving the local schools. The categories will be the same as last year and the judging will be conducted through the "Valley Arts Council."
