

The City of Ansonia Board of Police Commissioners and the Board of Alderman have approved a Limited Residential Parking Ordinance on the following streets: Page Street, Addison Street, Francis Street, Russell Street, Rutland Street, Rufus Street and Grove Street, between Division Street and Meadow Street.

This ordinance has been approved to reduce parking congestion for residents of the above listed streets. The ordinance will go into effect on December 1, 2019 as will winter parking restrictions.

Winter Parking rules will be in effect from December 1, 2019 thru March 31, 2019. This year parking will be on the odd side for the duration of the winter parking ban.

Residents of streets listed above will be able to obtain a residential parking sticker at the Ansonia Police Department by completing a Parking Permit Application and bringing it to the Ansonia Police Department Records Division.

The regulations are as follows: Residents by permit only. All other vehicles 2 hour limit between 10 AM – 8 PM Monday through Friday.

The ordinance, permit instructions and the application packet can be found on the City of Ansonia's website, Ansonia City Hall, and the Ansonia Police Department. A fillable PDF is also available on the City Website.

Public works will be erecting the signs in the near future. Residents will have time to obtain permits and there will be a grace period as we begin this program to allow residents time to get the appropriate paperwork completed. Winter Parking Regulations will go into effect on December 1, 2019

This is for informational purposes at this time and further information will be released when the parking permits are available and the new signs are installed. Enforcement will not begin until all signs are installed.
